



### **EVENT CHRONOLOGY**

### **Queensland Floods**

24 Dec 2010 to 26 Jan 2011









#### Background

Tropical Cyclone Tasha was initially analysed as a tropical low in the northern Coral Sea, southeast of Papua New Guinea on the 20th December.

The low maintained a south-westerly track towards the north Queensland coast over the forthcoming days. The low eventually moved into a very favourable environment for development on the 24th December and subsequently intensified to reach tropical cyclone intensity during the early hours of Christmas Day.

Tropical Cyclone Tasha remained as a category 1 system for only a matter of hours prior to its landfall along the North Tropical Coast near Gordonvale.

Widespread rainfall in the order of 150-250mm was experienced on the southern side of the system as it moved onto the coast. See Annex A for Tropical Cyclone Tasha Track Map.

On Monday the 10<sup>th</sup> of January, intense rainfall fell around Toowoomba and the Lockyer Valley generating a flash flood event. Toowoomba, the Lockyer Valley, Grantham and Helidon were severely impacted. Heavy rainfall continued to occur in the south east, generating widespread flooding around lpswich and Brisbane from the 12<sup>th</sup>. This was the largest flood event to impact the region since 1974.



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#### Summary of flood events preceding TC Tasha

Late November and December 2010 recorded high levels of rainfall resulting in widespread flooding on many rivers. Severe flooding was experienced in Queensland in terms of extent and impact and was the most significant in Australia since the 1970s. The downstream impacts continued throughout January. It was the wettest December on record for Queensland, and the second-wettest for the Murray-Daring Basin. This followed an extremely wet spring, the wettest on record for Queensland and the Murray-Darling Basin. Many catchments were already wet before the flooding rain impacted.

#### Rainfall

28 November to 4 December: Total rainfall for the week of was widely in the 100-300 mm range in central Queensland extending from Mackay to Emerald. Notable daily falls during this period included 143.6 mm at Mackay on 1 December and 228.0 mm at Mount Charlton (near Mackay) on 3 December.

8 to 13 December: Rainfall for the period widely exceeded 50 mm in much of the Queensland coast and an inland area in Queensland's central west. Notable daily falls during the period included 127.8 mm at Blackall on 8 December, 128 mm at Miriam Vale on 12 December.

19 to 20 December: A trough moved north over Queensland. Much of southern and central Queensland received a further 50 to 100 mm.

23 to 28 December: Further rain was brought into the region by the circulation associated with Tropical Cyclone Tasha, which made landfall south of Cairns on the morning of 25 December. Rainfall totals for the period exceeded 200 mm over a large area of central eastern Queensland, roughly bounded by Rockhampton, Carnarvon Gorge and Hervey Bay, with falls exceeding 400 mm in places. Similar falls extended northwards along the Queensland coast as far north as Cairns, and well as near the Gold Coast. Much of the eastern half of Queensland received at least 100 mm. The most widespread intense rainfall was on 27 December. Carnarvon set all time daily records with daily totals in excess of 200 mm, peaking at 273.6 mm.

On 26<sup>th</sup> December near the landfall of Tasha, daily totals included 140.2 mm at Rockhampton, 148 mm at Condamine on 27 December, and 165.4 mm at Bundaberg on 28 December.

#### Floods resulting from the rainfall

The rains from 23 to 28 December resulted in exceptional flooding in many parts of central and southern Queensland with many rivers reaching record levels. By 23 December, many rivers were already at or near flood level as a result of the rains in the preceding weeks (with some, notably the Dawson, experiencing major flooding). The rains during the following few days, on top of the pre-existing wet conditions, resulted in major flooding over a vast region. Except for the southeast coastal fringe south of Maryborough, almost every river in Queensland that is south of the Tropic of Capricorn and east of Charleville and Longreach reached major flood level at some stage during the period from 26 November to 7 January, mostly between 23 December and 4 January. Properties were inundated in at least 17 towns in Queensland, with the largest impacts in the towns of Theodore, Dalby, Chinchilla, Emerald, Bundaberg and Rockhampton.

On Monday the 10th of January, intense rainfall fell around Toowoomba and the Lockyer Valley generating a flash flood event. Toowoomba, the Lockyer Valley, Grantham and Helidon were severely impacted. Heavy rainfall continued to occur in the south east, generating widespread flooding around Ipswich and Brisbane from the 12th. This was the largest flood event to impact the region since 1974.

QPS report that between the beginning of November 2010 until 9 January 2011, 13 people were confirmed deceased from flood related issues. QPS report that since the 10th of January 2011, the death toll for flood-related incidents in SEQ Queensland has risen to 22. Since 30 November 2010 - 35 people have died as a result of flood-related incidents that have occurred in Queensland. There were 489 missing persons of which 480 have now been accounted for.
