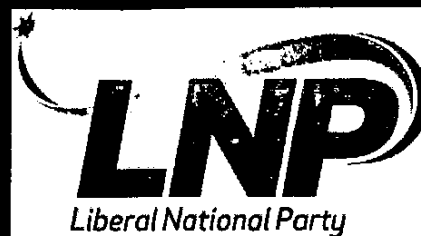

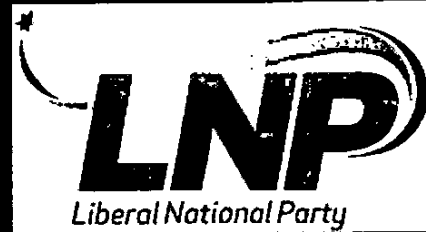
PLEASE RETURN WHITE PAGES.
