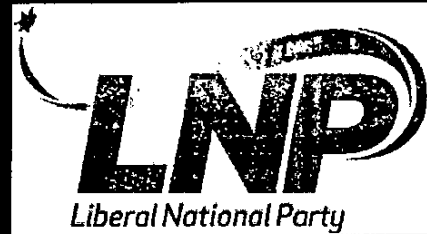

No, only from personal experience. Major floods that I can remember - 1956 - 1959 1974 - 2011 - There were others but not as significant.

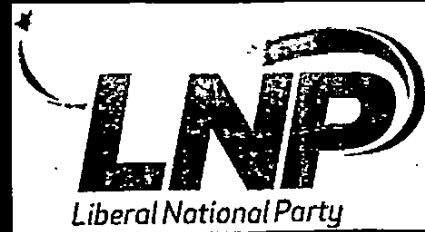
- Had you ever received evacuation information for flood / landslides / fires?
