No, but I haven't enquired either.

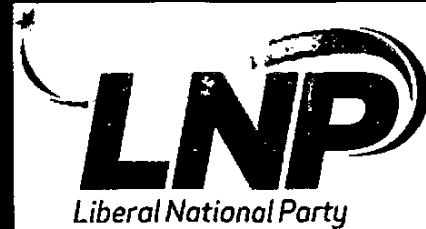
