

Katrina and I very much likewise enjoyed your company last Sunday night. I appreciate you sending through the form of submission and I attach the three pages of my reply.

My essential points are:-

- Better advance notice of likely extreme weather events and possible consequences (enough information soon enough and published well enough). I accept this was difficult in respect of the January 10 event but the point was demonstrated in the difference between the Lockyer Valley flash flood event and the situation with the Brisbane flood and Cyclone Yasi where there was significant notice and time to prepare and in consequence no loss of life.
- Flood level information being disclosed on a standard Local Council pre purchase Conveyancing search at a reasonable fee so that people can at least know what is possible in respect of the site they are looking at buying.
- Greater specific authority and capacity for local rural fire brigades which, by their nature, are already in the community and "on the ground" and at small expense could be trained in relation to flood warning and evacuation procedures. The failure to fund these organisations adequately is a blight on government.

Hope this is useful.
