Cooby closed at Pipeline Road and gates locked at dam wall;  Cressbrook gates closed at top. No spillway gates;  Perseverance has landslide on the way in and closed to local access only;  Cr. Strohfeldt tabled issue of activation of LDMG/Disaster Centre. CEO opposed action. QPS advised no disadvantages to activating. Dr.  advised he had recently been up north re. floods and strongly urged activation. Stated 12 hospitals currently isolated and issues arising with rotation of staff, supplies in particular oxygen to Chinchilla. All hospitals open but isolated.  Very heavy rain during meeting.  At about 1330hrs information then provided to meeting that there had been landslide at Mt. Kynoch and Toowoomba Range.  Cr. Strohfeldt then declared LDMG/District Disaster Centre activated.
