Statement of Edward Thomas Denman

I, Edward Thomas Denman, Plumbing Services Manager of Compliance and Regulatory Services, Brisbane City Council, of 266 George Street, Brisbane, in the State of Queensland, state on oath as follows:

- A. Attachment ETD-01 is a copy of a notice from the Commissioner of the Queensland Floods Commission of Inquiry (Commission) dated 2 November 2011 requiring Brett Turville to provide certain information to the Commission in the form of a statement by 14 November 2011 (Notice), a copy of a letter from Clayton Utz to the Commission dated 10 November 2011 advising that a statement prepared by me would be provided in response to the Notice and a copy of a letter from the Commission of the same date which advises that the Commission has no objections to me providing the statement.
- B. For the purposes of responding to the Notice and preparing this Statement I have, in my position as Plumbing Services Manager of Compliance and Regulatory Services of the Brisbane City Council (Council), had access to:
 - (a) the business records of Council; and
 - (b) Council officers; and
 - (c) in relation to the identification of the specific relevant provisions of the legislation, the advice of Council's solicitors,

to obtain information to provide a response to the Notice. Unless otherwise stated, the matters set out in this Statement are based on my own knowledge and the information derived from the above sources.

- C. The documents from the above sources and attached to this Statement have been collated by Council officers under my instruction.
- D. I set out below my responses to each of the questions set out in the Notice.

Qualifications and Background

 I hold a Diploma of Engineering Construction Hydraulics, Diploma of Business Management and a Certificate IV in Construction Hydraulics. I am also a licensed plumber and drainer and hold an open LPG and Town Gas installers licence.

- 2. I have been a licensed plumber and drainer for twenty years.
- 3. I have held the position of Plumbing Services Manager of Compliance and Regulatory Services for 3.5 years.
- 4. My previous work history is as follows:
 - (a) I have been employed at Council since 2002;
 - (b) I was initially employed by Council as a Plumbing Inspector. I held that position for approximately 5 years;
 - (c) I was then employed as a Senior Plumbing Officer at Council for a period of approximately 9 months;
 - (d) Prior to my employment at Council I worked as a Hydraulic Consultant, a Plumbing Site Manager / Foreman and a Licensed Plumbing Contractor.

Response to the Notice

- The Brisbane City Council's regulatory and enforcement role in relation to property
 owners or development proponents seeking to illegally connect stormwater infrastructure
 to Queensland Urban Utilities' sewerage infrastructure network
- Council has separate regulatory and enforcement roles in relation to illegal connections of stormwater infrastructure to Queensland Urban Utilities' (QUU's) sewerage infrastructure network under the *Plumbing and Drainage Act 2002* (PD Act), the *City of Brisbane Act 2010* (COB Act) and the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009* (SPA).
- 6. Although s. 193 of the *Water Supply (Safety and Reliability) Act 2008* (Water Supply Act) makes it an offence to discharge stormwater into QUU's infrastructure, Council has no regulatory or enforcement role under the Water Supply Act.

PD Act

- 7. The PD Act provides a framework for the assessment, approval and certification of plumbing and drainage work.
- 8. Council has responsibility for administering the Standard Plumbing and Drainage Regulation 2003 for its area (s. 89 of the PD Act). The Standard Plumbing and Drainage Regulation

mandates that plumbing and drainage work must comply with the Queensland Plumbing and Wastewater Code (**QPW Code**) and certain sections of the Plumbing Code of Australia (**PCA**). The connection of stormwater infrastructure to sewerage infrastructure is inconsistent with the PCA and the QPW Code.

- 9. Under the PD Act, Council may appoint inspectors (Plumbing Inspectors) to conduct investigations and inspections for monitoring and enforcing compliance with the PD Act and SPA that regulate plumbing and drainage (s. 114 of the PD Act). Council currently employs 31 Plumbing Inspectors within the Plumbing Services Group of the Compliance and Regulatory Services Branch.
- 10. A Plumbing Inspector has the same powers of entry as an "authorised person" under the *Local Government Act 2009* (**LGA**) (s. 114 of the PD Act). Those powers are contained in Chapter 5, Part 2, Division 1 of the LGA and include:
 - (a) the power to enter a public place without the need to obtain permission (s. 128 of the LGA);
 - (b) the power to enter private property with, and in accordance with, the occupier's permission (s. 129 of the LGA);
 - (c) the power to enter private property with, and in accordance with, a warrant (s. 130 of the LGA).
- 11. Although a Plumbing Inspector's power to enter private property under the PD Act is dependent upon obtaining either the occupier's consent or a warrant, in my experience it is rare for an occupier to refuse a Plumbing Inspector consent to enter their premises.
- 12. Council's enforcement powers with respect to non-compliant plumbing or drainage work are contained in Part 6, Division 2 of the PD Act. Those enforcement powers include:
 - (a) the power to issue a written notice to an owner of premises requiring the owner to do a stated thing. The circumstances in which Council may issue such a notice include where Council reasonably believes that plumbing or drainage on the premises:
 - (i) is in a condition, or functions in a way, that constitutes a danger or health risk to occupiers of the premises or the public; or

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- (ii) is defective and should be altered, repaired or replaced; or
- (iii) was installed without, or not in accordance with Council's approval. (s. 116(1) of the PD Act); and
- (b) the power to issue a written notice to a person who performed plumbing or drainage work requiring the person to do a stated thing. Council may issue such a notice if Council reasonably believes the work does not comply with the PD Act (s.116(2) of the PD Act).
- 13. For completeness I would note that s. 128N of the PD Act provides that a person must not discharge a prohibited substance (including stormwater) into an on-site sewerage facility. An "on-site sewerage facility" is defined by the PD Act as a facility installed on premises for either:
 - (a) treating sewage generated on the premises and disposing of the resulting effluent; or
 - (b) storing on the premises sewage generated on the premises for its subsequent disposal by collection off the premises.

On-site sewerage facilities are generally required in non-sewered areas of Brisbane. Moggill, for example, includes non-sewered areas.

The PD Act does not create an equivalent offence in sewered areas.

COB Act

- 14. Section 85(1) of the COB Act provides that the owner of a property must not connect (or allow the connection of) the "sewerage installation" for the property to any part of the "stormwater installation" for the property.
- 15. A "sewerage installation" includes:
 - (a) a sewer for a property or building;
 - (b) sanitary plumbing; and
 - (c) sanitary drainage.



- 16. A "stormwater installation" for a property includes any roof gutters, downpipes, subsoil drains or stormwater drain for the property.
- 17. Section 85(1) of the COB Act therefore prohibits the connection of stormwater to a property's private sewerage network.
- 18. Council may, by written notice, require the owner to perform work that is reasonably necessary for fixing or otherwise dealing with the sewerage installation (s. 85(4) and (7) of the COB Act). In my experience, the standard requirement in these notices is for the owner to engage the services of a licensed plumber or drainer to disconnect the stormwater pipe from the sewerage installation and seal off the connection. The owner must comply with the notice unless they have a reasonable excuse (s.85(8) of the COB Act).
- 19. In addition to the power to issue a written notice requiring remedial work, Council may prosecute an offence against s.85(1) of the COB Act in the Magistrates Court by way of a summary proceeding under the *Justices Act 1886*. Council does not have the ability to issue infringement notices for COB Act offences as they are not prescribed in the *State Penalties* and Enforcement Regulation 2003 as an infringement notice offence.
- 20. Section 85(3) of the COB Act also imposes a positive obligation on an owner to take all necessary steps to disconnect the facility, drainage or sewer from the stormwater installation once the owner becomes aware of the illegal connection (s. 85(3) of the COB Act).
- In addition to the power to direct a disconnection under s.85(4) of the COB Act, s. 84(1) of the COB Act provides that Council may, by written notice, require the owner of a property to connect a stormwater installation for the property to a Council stormwater drain in the way, under the conditions and within the time stated in the notice.
- 22. The COB Act does not make it an offence to fail to comply with a notice issued by Council under s.84(1) of the COB Act. If a person connects a stormwater installation under a requirement of the Council, the person must comply with Council's requirement (s. 84(5) of the COB Act). However, the COB Act does not make it an offence for an owner to *fail to connect* a stormwater installation to a Council stormwater drain in accordance with Council's requirement. In my opinion therefore, a s.84(1) notice has effect as a "warning letter" as there is no offence or penalty prescribed for non-compliance with the notice.

- 23. Council's investigation and inspection powers under the COB Act, which are additional to the powers under the PD Act, include:
 - (a) the power to enter private property with, and in accordance with, the occupier's permission (s. 118 of the COB Act);
 - (b) the power to enter private property with, and in accordance with, a warrant (s. 119 of the COB Act);
 - (c) the power to enter private property without the permission of the occupier to inspect work that was carried out under a permit or notice (s.121 of the COB Act); and
 - (d) the power to enter private property (other than a home) without the permission of the occupier under an approved inspection program (s.122 of the COB Act).

SPA

- 24. Connection to sewerage infrastructure may in some cases be incidentally regulated by the development assessment process under the SPA.
- 25. The development assessment process is undertaken by the Development Assessment branch of Council.
- 26. A development approval may be given subject to conditions recommended by the Principal Plumbing Officer. Conditions may also be imposed as part of the compliance assessment process under the PD Act.
- 1. The Brisbane City Council's regulatory and enforcement role in relation to property owners or development proponents seeking to illegally connect stormwater infrastructure to Queensland Urban Utilities' sewerage infrastructure network including:
 - a. whether the Council is aware of any instances of illegal connections exacerbating flooding during December 2010 or January 2011;
- 27. I have had regard to Council's electronic case management system known as Development and Regulatory Tracking (**DART**) for the purpose of responding to this question.
- 28. Attachment **ETD-02** is a report generated by DART showing those illegal connections of which Council was aware during the period December 2010 to January 2011.

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- 29. Attachment **ETD-02** shows that during the period December 2010 to January 2011, Council was aware of 7 cases in which a property's stormwater drainage system was unlawfully connected to either the property's private sanitary drainage or to QUU's sewerage infrastructure network.
- 30. Of the illegal connections listed in ETD-02, only one involved the connection of stormwater to sewerage infrastructure. That illegal connection was located in the suburb of Sunnybank and the property was not known or identified by Council as being flood affected in the January 2011 flood event. In my opinion therefore, the illegal connections of stormwater to sewerage infrastructure identified in ETD-02 could not be said to have exacerbated flooding during December 2010 or January 2011.
- Attachment ETD-03 is a further report generated by DART showing illegal connections which came to Council's attention after January 2011. I have included this report on the basis that such connections may have in fact been in existence during the December 2010 to January 2011 period.
- 32. Attachment ETD-03 shows that the Plumbing Services Group has investigated 16 illegal connections since January 2011 to the present. All property investigations are now completed, resulting in the removal of all illegal connections of stormwater to the QUU's sewerage infrastructure and sewerage to the stormwater network.
- 33. An analysis of ETD-03 shows:
 - (a) of the 16 investigations recorded, only 4 investigations concerned the connection of stormwater to sewerage infrastructure. Those investigations concerned properties located at West End, Kangaroo Point, Albion and Chermside;
 - (b) of those 4 illegal connections, only one illegal connection was located in a suburb that was flood-affected during the January 2011 flood event;
 - (c) however, the particular property concerned did not flood during the January 2011 flood event.
- 34. Therefore, even assuming that the illegal connections identified in **ETD-03** were in existence during December 2010 to January 2011, it is my opinion that such connections could not be said to have exacerbated flooding during December 2010 or January 2011.

 - the Council's modelling and mapping of overland flow paths including the extent;
- 35. The Compliance and Regulatory Services branch of Council does not undertake any modelling or mapping of overland flow paths. I am not familiar with Council's modelling and mapping of overland flow paths.
- 36. To the best of my knowledge, modelling and mapping of overland flow paths is an activity undertaken by the Development Assessment branch of Council.
- 1. The Brisbane City Council's regulatory and enforcement role in relation to property owners or development proponents seeking to illegally connect stormwater infrastructure to Queensland Urban Utilities' sewerage infrastructure network including:
 - c. whether the Council maintains a register of illegal connections;
- 37. Council does not maintain a specific register of illegal connections.
- 38. However, information on illegal connections is collected and stored as part of the DART system. A report can be generated from DART showing a list of properties with illegal connections and the investigation and enforcement activity undertaken by Council with respect to that property. Attachment ETD-02 is an example of such a report.
- 39. Attachment **ETD-04** is a screen shot of the DART system.
- 1. The Brisbane City Council's regulatory and enforcement role in relation to property owners or development proponents seeking to illegally connect stormwater infrastructure to Queensland Urban Utilities' sewerage infrastructure network including:
 - d. what compliance action the Council takes with respect to illegal connection, particularly as to rectification.
- 40. In my experience, where an illegal connection is identified, Council will first consult Council records to check whether an approval was lodged with Council for the work and, if an approval was lodged, to identify who performed the plumbing or drainage work.



- Where Council's records reveal that a licensed plumber or drainer performed the work, Council will contact the licensed plumber or drainer and provide them with the opportunity to rectify the illegal connection. In my experience, licensed plumbers or drainers will usually undertake rectification works.
- 42. If the licensed plumber or drainer fails to rectify the illegal connection, Council may:
 - (a) refer the plumber or drainer to the Plumbing Industry Council for disciplinary action; and
 - (b) notify the owner of the premises that they are responsible for rectifying the illegal connection and recommend that the owner engage the services of a licensed plumber to remedy the illegal connection.
- 43. If the owner fails to rectify the illegal connection, Council will issue a written notice to the owner requiring rectification, either under s. 116(1) of the PD Act or s. 85(4) of the COB Act.
- 44. In circumstances where Council has no record of the plumbing or drainage work being performed by a licensed plumber or drainer, Council will treat the illegal connection as unlicensed work and issue a notice to the owner of the property requiring rectification of the illegal connection. This may be done under either s. 116(1) of the PD Act or s. 85(4) of the COB Act.
- 2. The matters raised in paragraphs 22 to 38 of the submission of Queensland Urban Utilities to the Queensland Urban Utilities to the Queensland Floods Commission of Inquiry (enclosed)
- 45. Paragraph 24 of QUU's submission outlines the risk of stormwater infiltration into QUU's wastewater system posed by illegal connections.
- 46. In my opinion, the impact of illegal stormwater connections to sewerage infrastructure can be overstated. This is because of:
 - (a) the low incidence of illegal connections of stormwater to sewerage infrastructure; and
 - (b) the low volume of stormwater entering the sewerage infrastructure through illegal connections (the estimated total stormwater outflow for a standard 3 bedroom



dwelling during a rainfall event over a 24 hour period is approximately 50,000 to 100,000 litres).

- 2. The matters raised in paragraphs 22 to 38 of the submission of Queensland Urban Utilities to the Queensland Urban Utilities to the Queensland Floods Commission of Inquiry (enclosed), including:
 - the adequacy of the Council's statutory powers, including pursuant to the City of Brisbane Act 2010, Local Government Act 2009 and the Water Supply (Safety and Reliability) Act 2008, to take action to prevent stormwater from entering the sewerage infrastructure network; and
- 47. In my opinion, Council's powers under the PD Act and the COB Act are adequate to require the rectification of illegal connections. Council has no powers, nor do I consider requires powers, under the Water Supply Act with respect to illegal connections.
- 48. As I have outlined above, Council may require that rectification works be undertaken by either the licensed plumber or drainer who performed the work or the owner of the property.
- 49. It is Council's practice to first require the licensed plumber or drainer to rectify the works, and only require rectification by the owner as a last resort.
- 2. The matters raised in paragraphs 22 to 38 of the submission of Queensland Urban Utilities to the Queensland Urban Utilities to the Queensland Floods Commission of Inquiry (enclosed), including:
 - b. the Council's position in relation to extending the statutory powers of
 Distributor-Retailers under the Water Supply (Safety and Reliability) Act 2008
 to enter private property to investigate whether there are illegal stormwater
 connections and if so, to require plumbing regulators to remedy illegal
 stormwater connections.
- The extension of the statutory powers of the Distributor-Retailers under the Water Supply Act is a question of policy and is not a matter that falls within my role or expertise as Plumbing Services Manager.
