- Consideration of possible improvements or studies into Seqwater's facilities that may improve Seqwater's ability to manage events, e.g. investigations into increased flood storage capacity of the dams.
- Consideration of possible changes to the facilities or work practices of other organisations that may assist in the management of floods, e.g. bridge capabilities downstream of Wivenhoe (does increasing their flow capacity assist), emergency management procedures, communication systems, new technologies, etc.
